## WSU Course Information

Pre-license training is for pesticide applicators, consultants, and dealers who would like to obtain a license. All exam categories will be available on testing day and will be administered by Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA). This WSU training focuses on 8 of the 26 WSDA exams. Not all exam topics are covered. Courses do not cover aquatic, public health, seed treatment, soil fumigation, Pest Control Operator (PCO), or Structural Pest Inspector (SPI).

All license types should attend all 3 days of training *except* for Dealer Manager. Dealer Managers need to register for Day 1 only and return for the exam on the afternoon of Day 3.

If you hold a valid pesticide applicator license and are interested in adding a category, only attend the day that the category-specific information is covered.
