IPM Hands-On Workshops

The workshop topics rotate through the locations over a 5-year period.

IPM Workshop I: Site Preparation and Plant Selection

Bellingham • Whatcom Community College • October 7–8, 2009

Two-day hands-on workshop featuring soils and soil microbiology, mulching to reduce pesticide applications, root problem prevention and treatment, site preparation and proper planting techniques, proper plant selection for improved plant health and low maintenance landscaping.

IPM Workshop V: Plant Problem Diagnosis

Learn to diagnose and manage abiotic and pathogenic disease problems with an IPM approach.

Use references, hand lenses and microscopes to identify arthropod damage. Develop skills for effective insect management and utilizing IPM monitoring tools, biological and mechanical controls and low toxicity chemicals. Learn to identify and manage weeds with an IPM approach.
