Registration Instructions

A confirmation letter will be sent to the billing or optional address confirming the date(s) and location(s) for which you are registered. Contact our office at 509-335-2830 or pest@wsu.edu if there is an error in your confirmation letter.

Early registrations are those postmarked 14 days prior to the first day of the program.

All others are regular registrations. Note the early registration postmark dates are in the shaded columns.

Payment must be submitted with registration forms. Registration forms received without payment are not processed until payment is received. You can register online at <http://pep.wsu.edu> with a credit card.

Payment: Pay with check, money order, MasterCard, or VISA; WSU does not accept purchase orders. *Online or faxed registrations require MasterCard or VISA payment. CV# is the last three digits located on the back of card.*

Cancellations and refund requests can be made **until 10 days** prior to the date of the program for which you are registered. WSU Course Information

Pre-license training is for pesticide applicators, consultants, and dealers who would like to obtain a license. All exam categories will be available on testing day and will be administered by the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA). This WSU training focuses on 8 of the 26 WSDA exams. Not all exam topics are covered. Courses do not cover aquatic, public health, seed treatment, soil fumigation, Pest Control Operator (PCO), or Structural Pest Inspector (SPI).

All license types should attend all 3 days of training *except* for Dealer Manager. Dealer Managers need to register for Day 1 only and return for the exam on the afternoon of Day 3.

If you hold a valid pesticide applicator license and are interested in adding a category, only attend the day that the category-specific information is covered.
