# IPM Hands-On Workshops

## IPM Workshop IV: IPM for Insects and Weeds

Bellingham • Whatcom Community College • October 5–6, 2011

Use references, hand lenses, and microscopes to identify arthropod damage. Develop skills for effective insect management and utilizing IPM monitoring tools, biological and mechanical controls, and low toxicity chemicals. Learn to identify and manage weeds with an IPM approach.
