PART 1 – Choose WSDA License Types - Mark for ALL the types of licenses you need. Most people select only ONE type.

- License fees must be paid at the exam session. The WSU course fee does not include the WSDA license fee.
- Bring appropriate fee in the form of a check (payable to WSDA) or exact cash - there is NO pre-payment option.
- Picture identification is required at the testing session.

There are two categories of licenses – (1) Applicator (2) Non-Applicator (Dealer, Consultant and Structural Pest Inspector)

(1) Applicator – Applies pesticides as employee of a public agency, for hire, OR to your own or your employer's private property

- Work for a public agency – **Public Operator (\$33)**. Part 2 - Select Laws & Safety Exam and appropriate category exam(s).
- Work for a commercial application business - You can be the head of the pesticide application business (Commercial Applicator) or otherwise employed by the business (Commercial Operator).
 - Commercial Applicator (\$215)**: Part 2 - Select Laws & Safety Exam and appropriate category exams. As the CA, you must be licensed in all the categories the company works. Note: Additional fee for motorized power equipment.
 - Commercial Operator (\$67)**: Part 2 - Select Laws & Safety Exam and appropriate category exams. As the CO, you must be licensed in all the categories you work.
- Apply restricted-use pesticides to your own or your employer's private property – You can apply to either **agricultural property** (includes nursery, greenhouse or forest) or **non-agricultural property** (grain storage, privately-owned golf course, your own company's landscape).
 - **Agricultural Property** - Select one of the **Private Applicator** licenses below and the corresponding exam in Part 2.
 - Private Applicator (\$33)** - allows the use of any type of restricted use pesticide.
 - Limited Private Applicator (\$33/5 years)** - allows the use of restricted use herbicides only on non-production agricultural land such as pastures, rangeland, fencerows and areas around farm buildings.
 - Rancher Private Applicator (\$100/5 years)** - allows the use of restricted use herbicides and rodenticides on limited and non-production ag land. Limited production ag land is used to grow hay and grain crops that are consumed by the livestock on the farm where produced. No more than ten percent of the hay and grain crops may be sold each crop year.
 - **Non-Agricultural Property**
 - Private-Commercial Applicator (\$33)**: Part 2 - Select Laws & Safety Exam and appropriate category exams.

(2) Non-Applicator – Sells or consults on the use of pesticides or conducts wood destroying organism inspections.

- Dealer Manager** - Sells pesticides (herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, rodenticides, etc.) from a licensed Pesticide Dealer outlet. Part 2 - Select Dealer Manager Exam.
- **Consultant** - Provides information or technical advice about non-home & garden pesticides. Part 2 - Select Laws & Safety Exam and other appropriate category exams. *Note: operators/applicators (above) can consult without having Consultant license.*
 - Commercial Consultant (\$60)** – For hire
 - Public Consultant (\$33)** – Works for public agency
- Structural Pest Inspector** – Conducts wood destroying organism inspections. Part 2 - Select SPI Exam.
