Container Recycling Operation

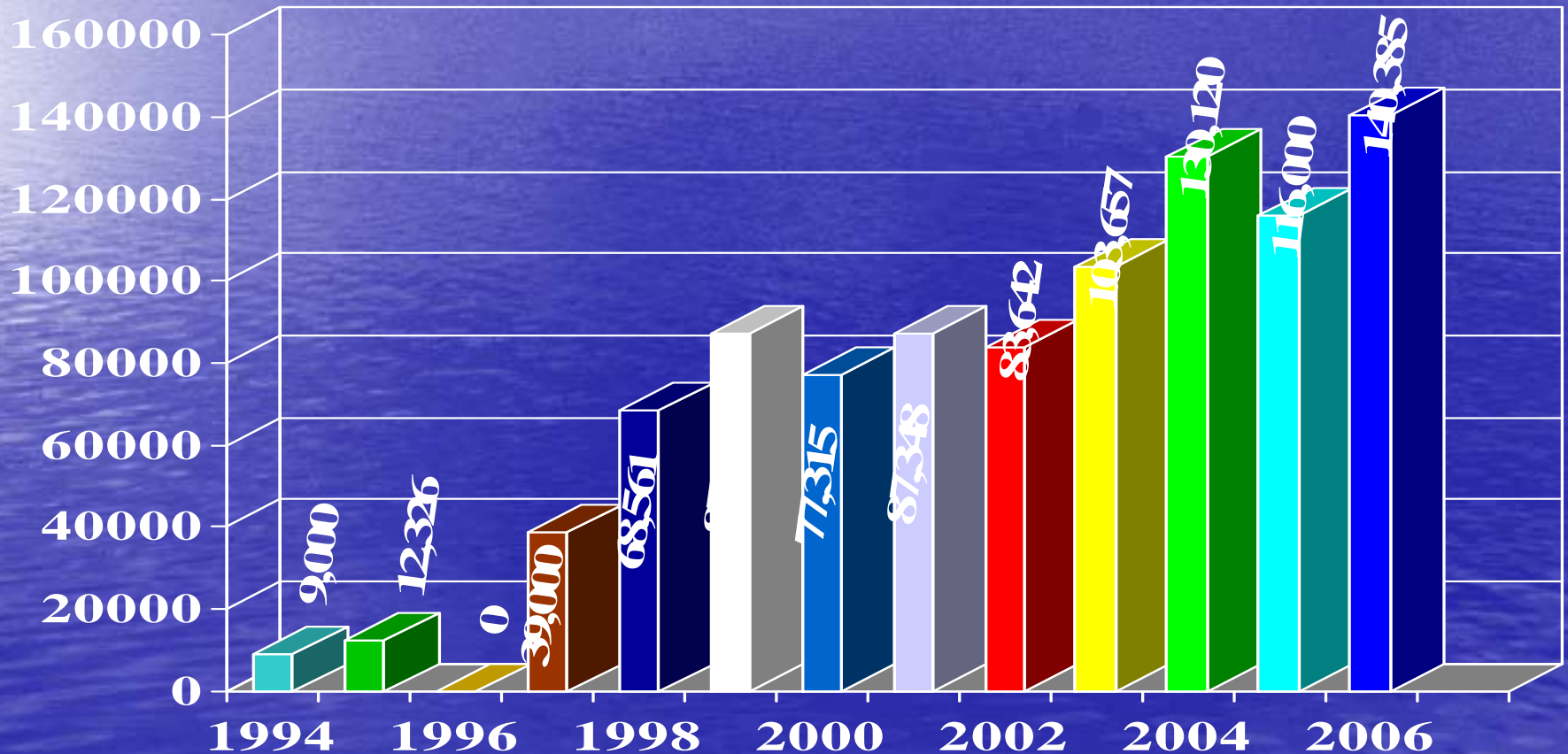
History of Program

A little history first:

- In 1993 the ISDA with the help of industry went in the pesticide container recycling business
- In 1995 - industry, EPA and the ISDA went in together to purchase equipment to recycle pesticide containers.
- F800 Ford, Granulator, Generator, Blower and trailer

Historical Summary

- CROP program has recycled over 870,000 pounds of containers.
- ISDA has kept over 652,000 pounds of recyclable plastic out of Idaho's landfills or possibly being disposed of illegally.

Container Recycling Operation 2007 Update

- The CROP program position is now fulltime.
- This will in a year round program for customers.
- ISDA also purchased a new F750 truck, trailer, granulator and generator.
- The old CROP equipment has been moved to eastern Idaho.
- Two mobile CROP recycling vehicles to better service customers.
- Idaho will increase volume.
- Be better situated if EPA makes recycling mandatory.



Container Recycling Operation 2007 To Pay For this?

- ISDA raised the pesticide registration fee \$15.00 to registrants to help pay for the CROP program.
- If ISDA should lose some of the funding, we can still support the program.
- Industry and Legislative Support.



Container Recycling Operation 2007 Conclusions

- ISDA is working hard to make the CROP program more user friendly.
- We will now have a truck in SW Idaho as well as one in eastern Idaho.
- Will increase our effectiveness in chipping for our customers.
- We are making the commitment for the long term in both personnel and equipment.
- Better positioned to collect more, especially if EPA move to mandatory.
