Early registrations are those postmarked 14 days prior to the first day of the program. All others are regular registrations. Note the early registration postmark deadlines in the shaded column above.

Substitutions are accepted anytime. **Transfers** can be made **until 5 days prior** to the date of the program for which you are registered; after that time, course fee is forfeited. Transfers are limited to WSU Urban IPM & Pesticide Safety Education classes offered before June 30, 2018 (see pep.wsu.edu for complete list of courses). Pre-License Pesticide Applicator Review

Pre-License pesticide applicator review is for persons interested in preparing for pesticide license exams.
For recertification program information, please go to pep.wsu.edu or call 509-335-2830.

WSU Course Information

Pre-License pesticide applicator review is for pesticide applicators, consultants, and dealers who would like to obtain a license. All exam categories will be available on testing day and administered by the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA). This WSU review is conducted in English and focuses on eight of the 26 WSDA exams. Not all exam topics are covered. Courses do not cover aquatic, public health, seed treatment, soil fumigation, Pest Control Operator (PCO), or Structural Pest Inspector (SPI) unless otherwise specified.

All license types should attend both days of review except for Dealer Manager. Dealer Managers need to register for Day 1 only and return for the exam on the afternoon of Day 2.

If you hold a valid pesticide applicator license and are interested in adding a category, register for the day the category-specific information is covered.

If you are seeking a PCO General or PCO Structural license, register for the class on November 28. To obtain a WSDA pesticide applicator license, you will also need to pass the Laws and Safety Exam. If you want to review the material for the Laws & Safety Exam, also register for November 29. The WSDA exam session will be offered the afternoon of November 30. Do not register and pay for November 30 if you attend on November 28 and 29; just show up for the exam at 12:30 pm.

March 21 and 22, 2018 will be a review course specifically for PCO General and PCO Structural, including laws and safety. The WSDA exam session will take place on the afternoon of March 22.

License and testing fees must be paid to Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) on the day of the exam. **The registration fee paid to WSU to attend the training course does NOT cover your license and testing fee.** License fees are below. WSDA charges a \$25 testing fee per person taking the exams. Have payment (exam fee + license fee = total fee) in check or money order **payable to WSDA**. **WSDA does not accept cash, purchase orders or credit cards.** You must provide some form of picture identification.
